A CENTREPIECE HOSPITAL FOR A NEW NEIGHBOURHOOD

Set on the outskirts of the city, the new Estaing Hospital represents a real opportunity for Clermont-Ferrand to expand beyond its current boundaries. A real « driver of urban generation », it is a centrepiece for a new neighbourhood, a tertiary hub dedicated to healthcare.

With its monumental entry concourse, the building is a landmark for the new neighbourhood. Its large central avenue is planted with bamboo and dotted with spaces for relaxation and meet-ups, extending the existing urban fabric while also defining future thoroughfares. The split-volume layout is another aspect of the primary structure, and offers more intimate, domestic spaces.
