Euro-mediterranean University, Fès, Morocco

Between town and fields, the valley of the Oued Ljaouahir will host the construction of the university, becoming an important development area. The project is composed by three programmatic bands, linked by a large courtyard, the heart of the site, protected by a large canopy. Each entity, well distinct, is connected in a system of

terraces opened on the large euro-mediterranean garden. The staging of the programmes offer some views from a balcony onto the valley, from the public spaces of the esplanade, the mixed-used space of the canopy, to the domestic scale of the “medina” composed by housings with courtyard and passages.
